- Cancellations after this date: No refund

Should unforeseen circumstances force relocation or can<mark>cellation, fees will</mark> be refunded minus any costs already incurred.

Speaker Blackout

Subject to approval from the organising committee, sponsors may use their speaker for other engagements directly either side of the conference as long as it meets the following criteria:

- 2. The engagement is not more than four hours (half-day)
