Aligning the Stars in Periodontal Plastic Surgery: Master Class

WORKSHOP SYNOPSIS:

Masterclasses in music aim to teach already advanced musicians and to refine their performance at a high level. In addition, they usually provide insight into the teacher's approach, making the work processes behind the on-stage performance visible.

Analogous to masterclasses in the musical world, the objective of "Aligning the Stars in Periodontal Plastic Surgery" is not limited to deepening methods in periodontal plastic surgery or reinforcing established operative techniques. The primary aim is to offer participants a structured pathway for advancing their intraoperative technical performance from an advanced to an expert level. Based on the most recent results from expertise research, surgical procedures of varying complexity are deconstructed into e.g. flap preparation or suturing, practised individually on suitable models, and subsequently recombined into complete procedures.

Emphasis is placed on practical work on a range of models, supplemented by concise theoretical modules. The course introduces participants to the methods of deliberate practice, a training approach that has been thoroughly investigated in the domains of music, sport, and several surgical specialties – deliberate practice as the cornerstone of expertise in periodontal plastic surgery!

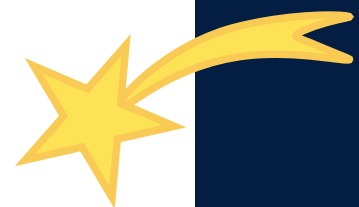
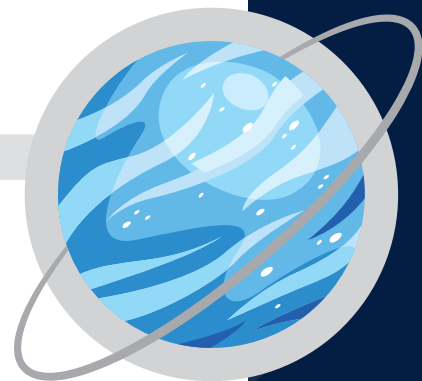

WORKSHOP SYNOPSIS:

This advanced hands-on workshop explores the strategic selection and clinical application of biomaterials across a spectrum of oral regenerative procedures, from alveolar ridge preservation to soft tissue augmentation.

Emphasis will be placed on understanding how material properties—such as resorption rate, biocompatibility, and structural stability—align with specific clinical indications and desired outcomes. Through case-based discussions and evidence-based insights, participants will gain practical guidance on choosing appropriate biomaterials for hard and soft tissue management, optimizing healing, and enhancing long-term aesthetic and functional results. The session aims to bridge scientific principles with daily clinical decision-making, enabling clinicians to tailor regenerative approaches to individual patient needs.

WORKSHOP SYNOPSIS:

Primordial and primary prevention of peri-implant diseases are the key factors to achieve long-term success when placing dental implants. Moreover, the early treatment of peri-implant mucositis is the main preventive strategy to avoid peri-implantitis. Therefore, the establishment of a well-organized and continuous maintenance protocol is crucial in the management of peri-implant diseases. In the first part of the presentation, we will discuss how prevention should be applied in the daily practice, before and after placing dental implants. We will also discuss which tools are available to decontaminate the implant surface in the treatment of peri-implant mucositis and peri-implantitis.

For many years, surgical treatment of peri-implantitis has been one of the main therapeutic options to stop the disease progression. Surgical options include access surgeries or combined approaches. The latter are particularly resective surgeries, reconstructive therapies and relevant in complex defects and in cases where we also have to modify the quantity and/or quality of the peri-implant soft tissues. We will discuss several cases in which we have performed different surgical approaches with the aim of halting the pathology. However, it must be borne in mind that these procedures are often complex, are associated with patient morbidity and have significant learning curves. Therefore, in the second part of the session, we will discuss a new minimally invasive, flapless surgical treatment that is within the reach of any professional, presenting the results from different research we have been performing over the past years. At the end of the workshop we will have the chance to show a live demonstration on the use of the GBT machine and how to apply it around teeth and implants.

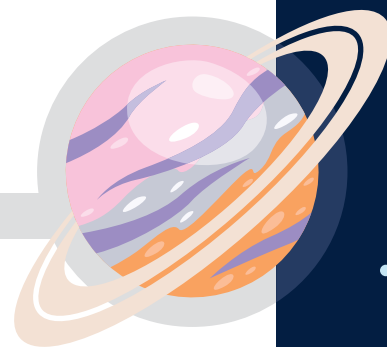

WORKSHOP SYNOPSIS:

This full-day course explores contemporary implant solutions for achieving predictable outcomes in complex aesthetic cases, from immediate implant placement to ridge reconstruction. It addresses the clinical challenges associated with periodontally compromised patients, including reduced bone volume, soft tissue deficiencies, and high aesthetic expectations. Emphasis is placed on structured decision-making, implant system selection, and the application of evidence-based protocols, with a particular focus on immediate placement and provisionalisation in the aesthetic zone. The programme also highlights the role of the Nobel Biocare N1™ system within a modern surgical and prosthetic workflow, alongside strategies for managing hard and soft tissue to optimise aesthetic outcomes.

Through a combination of lectures, digital workflow integration, and case-based discussions, participants will develop practical skills in immediate implant protocols, risk assessment, and treatment sequencing for complex cases. The course introduces fully digital approaches, including CBCT-based planning, guided and flapless surgery, dynamic navigation, and temporisation techniques, as well as the "one abutment, one time" concept to preserve soft tissue architecture. By the end of the course, attendees will be equipped with clear, actionable protocols to enhance precision, improve aesthetic results, and confidently apply these techniques in clinical practice.



KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



Dr Rino Burkhardt

Switzerland



Dr Rino Burkhardt graduated from the University of Zurich and received his doctorate from the Medical Faculty of the same University. He is an EFP (European Federation of Periodontology) and SSP (Swiss Society of Periodontology) board certified specialist in periodontology and received his Masters degree from the Medical Faculty of the University of Berne (MAS in Periodontology).

In 2004 he won a prize from the European Federation of Periodontology for his research in microsurgery. Since 1996 he runs a private clinic in Zurich, limited to periodontology and implantology. Currently, he is the vice president of the Clinical Research Foundation for the Promotion of Oral Health and holds an honorary associate professorship at the University of Hong Kong and a visiting associate professorship at the University of Michigan. Besides his clinical activities he is a senior lecturer and scientific collaborator at the University of Zurich. He is an active member of the Swiss Society of Periodontology (SSP), the European Academy of Esthetic Dentistry (EAED), the European Association for Osseointegration (EAO), and former president of the Swiss Society of Implantology (SGI).

Dr Hatice Hasturk

USA



Dr Hatice Hasturk is a full professor and the director of the Center for Clinical and Translational Research at the ADA Forsyth Institute. She also holds an adjunct associate professor position at the Boston University School of Dental Medicine and a lecturer position at the Harvard University School of Dental Medicine. She received her dental degree and Ph.D. in periodontology from Hacettepe University in Ankara, Turkey, and a certificate of advanced graduate studies in periodontology from Boston University. She is a board-certified periodontist who practices alongside her research activities.

Dr Hasturk's research has focused on the mechanisms linking periodontitis to systemic inflammatory diseases, including diabetes and cardiovascular disease, as well as the treatment of periodontitis by regulating the inflammatory response. She has received NIH and Industry grants to study inflammation and novel therapeutics for resolving inflammation. Her research focus has been on translational research since the early 2000s, supported by grants from the NIH/NIDCR, industry, and foundations. She has authored/co-authored 143+ original articles with an h-index of 60, numerous abstracts, and book chapters in peer-reviewed journals.

Dr Hasturk is the recipient of the 2016 International Association of Dental Research (IADR) William Geis Award, the 2020 American Academy of Periodontology (AAP) Clinical Research Award, and the 2020-2021 American Dental Association (ADA) Norton Ross Award for Excellence in Clinical Research. She was inducted as a Fellow of the American College of Dentists in 2022. She is a member of the IADR, AAP, ADA, European Federation of Periodontology, and International Academy of Periodontology.

Prof Alpdogan Kantarci

Dr Alpdogan Kantarci, DDS, PhD is a Board-certified specialist of Periodontology (C.A.G.S.) and a Diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology. He is the Erwin Schaeffer Endowed Chair, Professor with Tenure, and the Chair of the Department of Developmental and Surgical Sciences at the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry. He was previously a Professor and Senior Member of the Staff at the ADA Forsyth Institute, an Associate Professor at Harvard University School of Dental Medicine, and an Associate Professor at Boston University's Henry Goldman School of Dental Medicine. Dr Kantarci has mentored more than 60 theses and directed and taught in several graduate and postgraduate clinical and didactic dentistry courses. He serves on the editorial board of more than 20 dental and medical scientific journals. He holds several patents. He has published more than 220 articles in peer-reviewed scientific journals, written book chapters, and presented more than 500 oral talks. He is the Executive Director of the International Academy of Periodontology (IAP), member of the American Academy of Periodontology (AAP), and the International Association of Dental Research (IADR), where he served in many leadership positions.
