Coffee cart

Barista coffee will be available for conference delegates on a complimentary basis included as part of their registration. The barista cart is approximately the size of an exhibition site. Espresso partners confirmed before 5 June 2026 have the option to incorporate their cart into their exhibition build or have it located immediately adjacent, after this time this option may not be available depending on the expo floor plan.

Marketplace partner

A networking space is an excellent opportunity for organisation to come face-to-face with delegates and key decision makers throughout the conference. Catering breaks will be held within the networking area on both days of the conference.

Note that no walls are provided in the space. This creates an open and welcoming environment for you to network with delegates.

Registration

- One full conference registration for an organisation representative, including access to sessions, daily catering and a ticket to the welcome reception and the conference dinner

Inclusions

- 3m × 2m allocated area
- Power to area (if requested)
- Furniture package (either two couches and coffee table, or bar leaner and 4 stools)
- Organisation logo and profile in the exhibitor section of the app.
- Organisation logo included on the conference website, linking to your organisation website.
- Access to full delegate list (except for those who have requested privacy).

Furniture package

You will be required to select a furniture package for your networking space in the Marketplace. This will consist of either 2× couches and one coffee table or a bar leaner and four stools.

Package availability and colours are on a first in basis so we recommend you advise your preference during the booking process. Any furniture upgrades or additional items are payable directly to our supplier.

Allocation of space

Location preference will be allocated to confirmed sponsors based on level of support first until 14 June. After this, remaining spaces will be allocated to organisations on a first in basis.



Terms and conditions

Our standard terms and conditions for partnership are set out here and overleaf.

Anyone who is considering applying for a partnership opportunity should read these before submitting an application, to ensure that it complies with these conditions.

Booking and payment conditions

All prices are in New Zealand Dollars and exclude Goods and Services Tax (GST) of 15%. Full payment is due on the 20th of the month following the original invoice date or prior to the conference, whichever is first.

Cancellation

Any cancellations must be made in writing to the Exhibition Manager. In the event of cancellation of a partnership package up to Friday 24th April 2026 a full refund less an administration charge of \$150 + GST will be made. Cancellations after this date will be at the discretion of the symposium organising committee.

Te Ora o te Whānau Charitable Trust reserves the right to cancel, postpone or change the venue of the hui in case of circumstances beyond their control. In such a case all monies paid to date will be refunded in full less any expenses incurred. The liability of the organisers will be limited to that amount.

Health and safety

Te Ora o te Whānau Charitable Trust, NZICC and Conference Innovators take the health and safety of our delegates, partners and suppliers seriously. An “exhibition” manual will be provided to all exhibitors six weeks prior to the symposium highlighting all the health and safety obligations. This will provide full details around compliance when packing in your displays and working throughout the Empowering Indigenous Voices Symposium. Please note that all electronic equipment plugged in onsite must be tagged and tested. By agreeing to exhibit at the symposium, you agree to adhere to our health and safety policy.

Insurance and liability

Partners must ensure that they are adequately covered for public liability insurance. This refers to damage or injury caused to third parties/visitors in the vicinity of their displays.

Neither Te Ora o te Whānau Charitable Trust, Conference Innovators, Exhibition Hire Services, NZICC nor any of their staff, employees, agents or other representatives shall be held accountable for, or liable for, and the same are released from accountability, or liability for any damage, loss, harm or injury to the person or any property of the displays, however caused or any of its staff, employees, agents or other representatives.

In the event of industrial disruption and/or equipment failure due to power supply problems Te Ora o te Whānau Charitable Trust, Conference Innovators, Exhibition Hire Services, NZICC will not be held liable and accept no responsibility for loss of monies incurred by sponsors or damage to property.

The organisers accept no liability for damage to partners equipment by loss, damage, theft, fire, water, storms, strikes, riots, or any cause whatsoever. Partners are advised to insure against such liability.

Provision of information

Six weeks prior to the symposium all organisations installing custom stands must provide the contact details of their appointed stand contractor, together with a detailed plan showing dimensions of the stand design for approval by the venue and the conference organisers.

Designed submitted must contain information such as stand layout, banner/light rigging and walls/solid heights.

Registration

All partnership packages include a certain number of complimentary registrations. Registration links will be provided to the key booking contact for each organisation in due course. Staff not registered as partner staff will not be allowed access.
