





Participation as a sponsor is at the discretion of the organisers and the organisers reserve the right to approve sponsorship materials.

Cancellation policy

The Hauora Taiwhenua Rural Health Network reserves the right to change the venue and duration of the event if exceptional circumstances demand this. In the event of a change of venue and/or duration, the agreement to participate will remain in force so long as the sponsor is informed in reasonable time before the event.

If, for reasons beyond the Hauora Taiwhenua Rural Health Network's control or for reasons of delegate health and safety the conference is cancelled, then the sponsorship amount will be refunded after deduction of expenses already incurred. The Hauora Taiwhenua Rural Health Network will not be liable for any expenses incurred by

sponsors in preparation of material for the conference or the supply of goods and services.

In the case of cancellation by the sponsor, notification in writing should be sent to the conference organiser. A refund of fees paid (less a cancellation fee of 50% of the value of the sponsorship) will be made to any sponsor cancelling before Wednesday 31 January 2024. No refunds will be provided after this date.

Full payment must be completed by Thursday 29 February 2024.
