Booking and payment conditions

All prices are in New Zealand Dollars and exclude Goods and Services Tax (GST) of 15%. Full payment is due on the 20th of the month following the original invoice date or prior to the conference, whichever is first.

Cancellation

Any cancellations for sponsorship and/or exhibition must be sent in writing to the conference organisers (Conference Innovators). The following cancellation policy will apply:

- For cancellations until 31 May 2026 (inclusive), you will be refunded in full, less 25% administration charge; this will be deducted from the refunded fee (if paid) or invoiced for immediate payment.
- Cancellations from 1 June – 31 August 2026 (inclusive), 50% of the total amount will be refunded (if paid) or invoiced for immediate payment.
- For cancellations from 1 September 2026 onwards, the full amount will be invoiced and charged and no refunds will be made.

All relevant refunds will be made within 30 days after the conference dates.
